

MARIJUANA HEMP-DERIVED THC Δ 8, 9, 0, A, ETC.

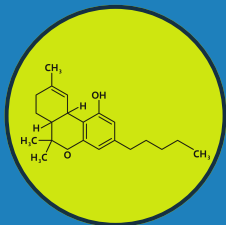
Hemp and marijuana are both part of the cannabis plant family and both produce cannabinoids with delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and cannabidiol (CBD) being the most commonly known. Research has found that the cannabis plant produces between 80 and 100 cannabinoids and about 300 non-cannabinoid chemicals¹

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?



Delta-8 is found in the hemp plant, but in much smaller quantities than Delta-9. Although Delta-8 is supposed to be weaker than Delta-9 in its psychoactive properties, it can be just as psychoactive as Delta-9 depending on how it is used.²



Delta-10, Delta-0, and THCa are all different cannabinoids that come from hemp. Not much is known about the long-term effects of any of these. It is reported that Delta-10, similarly to Delta-8, doesn't have as strong of a high as Delta-9, whereas Delta-0 is supposed to be much stronger than Delta-9. Current research is leading scientists to believe that these variants can cause mental health problems similar to Delta-9.³
