

## MARIJUANA AND MENTAL HEALTH

Studies have found a link between marijuana use and mental health problems, such as depression, anxiety, suicidal thoughts, lack of motivation, and personality disturbances.

## MARIJUANA USE CAN ALSO CAUSE:

Paranoia and hallucinations

Social anxiety

Increased risk and worsening of schizophrenia

Increased risk of bipolar disorder

## MARIJUANA'S LINK TO SUICIDE



Studies indicate a link between marijuana use and thoughts of suicide (suicidal ideation), suicide planning, and suicide attempt.

In Colorado, one of the first states to legalize adult use, marijuana is the number one drug in the systems of youth ages 10-19 who have died by suicide.<sup>2</sup>
